### **Studio 650 Policy**

The Shorewood-Troy Public Library is committed to providing a safe and inviting space for teens to gather and engage in individual and group activities. Studio 650 is a space designed to meet the needs of the social nature and unique characteristics of this age group.

All activities and programs available in Studio 650 are designed solely for this age group; no other patrons, programs, or events will be accommodated in this area during Studio 650's open hours. Meeting Room A is available for use by all patrons. Adults wishing to browse and checkout materials from the Studio 650 Collection during open hours are welcome to do so, but the recreation space and equipment is reserved exclusively for teen use.

Studio 650 provides resources for users including laptops with Internet access, displays of books from the young adult collection, a 40" television with gaming consoles, study tables, and programs.

#### Guidelines

- Studio 650 is open during regular library operating hours. The space closes 15 minutes before the library closes.
- Adult/Teen Services and Children's Librarians monitor and resolve problematic behavior.
- During open hours, Studio 650 will only be accessible to patrons ages 11-17.
- Teens are strongly encouraged to use resources and equipment during Studio 650's operating hours.
- The Patron Code of Conduct of the Shorewood-Troy Public Library applies to those that visit Studio 650.
- Snacks and covered drinks will be allowed in Studio 650. Messes must be cleaned before Studio 650 closes.
- Those who fail to conform to the Patron Code of Conduct and comply with other Library policies will be asked to vacate Studio 650.
